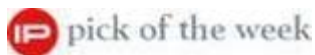
Last semester, as part of Osgoode's [Intellectual Property Law and Technology Intensive Program](#), I had the opportunity to work with in-house counsel at [AstraZeneca Canada](#). Having previously completed graduate studies in organic chemistry, I had always been very interested in the scientific aspects of the drug development process so I was very excited to have the chance to learn about the legal issues pharmaceutical companies face after a product has been developed. While issues relating to intellectual property law were certainly central to the work I carried out over the semester, I was also exposed to other areas of law important to AstraZeneca Canada's business.
